

Prof. Gian Luca Romani (University of Chieti, Italy)

Gian Luca Romani is professor of Physics. Since 1992 he has been the director of the Institute of Advanced Biomedical Technologies, at the University of Chieti. Gian Luca Romani retired at the end of 2017 and in 2018 was appointed as Professor Emeritus by the Italian Ministry of Education and University. At the end of 2018, he was also appointed as Research Delegate by the rector of the University of Chieti. His research activity has always been focused on applications of multimodal functional neuroimaging to the study of the human brain by means of MEG, EEG, fMRI and other noninvasive imaging technologies. GLR has been PI or Co-PI in several EU projects during FP5, FP6 and FP7 and Horizon 2020, as well in the NIH Human Connectome Project. Presently he is co-PI in the project ConnectToBrain (ERC SYNERGY), together with Risto Ilmoniemi and Ulf Ziemann.
