

**Prof. Shirley Fecteau (Laval University, Canada)**

Shirley Fecteau earned a PhD degree in Biomedical Sciences from University of Montreal (honor, 2005) and trained as a postdoctoral fellow and instructor at Harvard Medical School (2005-2010). She currently holds a Canada Research Chair in Cognitive Neuroplasticity (2010-) and is an Associate Professor at Université Laval. She serves as Deputy Editor for *Brain Stimulation* Elsevier and as an Editor for *Scientific Reports* Nature Publishing Group. She is also Faculty at the Harvard CME Course in Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation since 2005. Her research uses non-invasive neuromodulation (transcranial magnetic and electric stimulation) combined with neuroimaging (magnetic resonance imaging and electroencephalography) to understand human behaviours, cognition and psychiatric symptoms, especially in addiction, anxiety and depression.
